# Canadian Postal Codes Metros

### Introduction:

Our Canadian Metropolitan Areas includes current postal code info, along with the metropolitan area that the postal code belongs to, according to Statistics Canada (the Canadian equivalent of the U.S. Census Bureau).

Statistics Canada currently defines 151 metropolitan areas. Below is a sample from our file.

### Metro Master File (can-metros.csv):

Note: CMA is for ‘**Census Metropolitan Area**’ which is a large metropolitan area, or adjacent to that area and within commuting distance. It must have a population of at least 100,000 of which 50,000 live in the urban core of the CMA. This can be considered ‘**Urban.**’

CAs are ‘**Census Agglomerations**’ which are areas with a core population of at least 10,000. This can be considered ‘**Suburban.**’

The MetroID column is our own unique number assigned to each metropolitan area. It is then appended to the end of our Canadian Postal Code products which have Metropolitan Areas.

Note: currently about 92% of our postal codes fall within the CMA or CA metropolitan areas. If an area does not have a MetroID, then it is considered ‘**Rural.**’

Additionally, Statistics Canada considers a CA Small if it has less than 30,000, Medium is 30,000 to 99,999. All CMAs are considered Large (100,000 or more).

The dwellings are the total number of dwellings which includes anything that is an enclosed shelter from the elements with a roof, walls, doors and windows and with a source of heat or power available.

The Area is measured in Square Miles. To convert to Square Kilometers, multiply it by 2.58999.

We also include this file which is a cross-reference between our Metro ID and Statistics Canada Metro ID (OrigID). This is a sample:
